### **SCHOOLHOUSE ROCKED JOINS GRAYSON COUNTY CONSERVATIVES IN OPPOSING TEXAS HB3/SB2**

Grayson County, TX – The Schoolhouse Rocked Podcast, a prominent advocate for homeschooling and educational freedom, has officially signed on in support of Grayson County Conservatives' letter opposing Texas House Bill 3 (HB3) which is the companion bill to Texas Senate House Bill 2 (SB2). The legislation, touted as a 'School Choice' initiative, is under fire for threatening the autonomy of private and home education by introducing government oversight through taxpayer-funded education savings accounts.

In aligning with the opposition, Schoolhouse Rocked echoes concerns that HB3 undermines conservative values, expands bureaucracy, and risks replicating regulatory overreach seen in states like Indiana and Florida. “We remember the hard-fought legal battles and the sacrifices made by countless brave homeschooling families to secure the right to educate their children free from government interference. We refuse to jeopardize that freedom by accepting government funds that inevitably come with government control.” said Yvette Hampton, founder and host of Shoolhouse Rocked.

The letter, backed by widespread citizen resistance—including 502 testimonies against HB3 and 12,500 critical comments—urges legislators to reject the bill and preserve the independence of private schools and homeschooling.
